- ◆ Authors: (including affiliated College & department)
- ◆ Abstract (no more than 500 words, no tables or graphs) should include Introduction/background, Study Objective(s), Methods, Results, Conclusions, Funding (if applicable) and up to 3 Key Words.
- ◆ Please list at the bottom if the abstract has been previously presented. We welcome presentations of all educational scholarship even if it has been previously presented at a regional or national meeting during the last 12 months. Our intent is to highlight the education research occurring on the OUHSC campus.

Formative Feedback Forum Abstract:

- ◆ Title: (no more than 100 characters)
- ◆ Authors: (including affiliated College & department)
- ◆ Abstract (no more than 500 words, no tables or graphs) should include:
 - ◇ Introduction/Background i.e., gap in literature, importance, novelty and Study Objective(s),
 - ◇ Research design, i.e., pre/post test, randomized control, population, proposed data analysis; OR Planned educational innovations
 - ◇ Discussion: Expected outcomes, how information will add to the literature and improve
